BISHOP WESLEY J. ARIJE



The son of a renowned preacher and successor to the throne of his ancestors was born into the royal family of The Arije ninu Adura chieftaincy in Nigeria, Africa. As a preacher's son, Wesley was convinced that preaching was the one thing that he did not want to do. God's call however could not be resisted.

His father trained him at an early age as a carpenter. He built on that foundation by attending the Technical Training Institute in Nigeria in the same field. God rewarded his scholastic achievement in 1978. He was the last recipient of 21 scholarships given by the federal government to attend an engineering institution in the United States.

Bishop Arije graduated from the State Technical Institute of Knoxville, Tennessee; received a Bachelor of Science degree with a major in Civil Engineering and a minor in Business Administration from Southern Illinois University in Carbondale, Illinois; obtained a Master's degree in Structural Engineering at the University of Memphis in 1985; and completed his Doctoral degree in Engineering Science via Distance Learning in 1999. In addition, in 1986 Pastor Arije attended the C.H. Mason System of Theological Seminary and graduated with a Master's Certificate. He also completed his Doctor of Divinity degree coursework at MASTER'S International School of Divinity.

He professed salvation at an early age but his true commitment and sanctification did not begin until years later and after being nurtured by the anointed ministries of Bishop C. W. and Mother Addie Gillespie in Carbondale, Illinois. It was there, when in 1981, the Lord called him to a "walk of faith" and "of sanctification". "My Son", as Mother Gillespie affectionately calls him, "is a gifted preacher who will one day be a great pastor!" "Mark those who labor among you" is the oracle Bishop Gillespie so often recites to his son in the ministry, Bishop Arije.

In 1983, upon moving to Memphis, Tennessee to continue his secular education, God gave him a part in His ministry with a dazzling vision and a mission to go and deliver His people. Pastor Arije served as an Assistant Pastor to Bishop Samuel L. Lowe, the Prelate of the Fifth Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction of the Church of God in Christ for 16 1⁄2 years. During this period, he served in the capacities of the Dean of UJAC, Sunday School Superintendent, and Jurisdictional Business Manager. In 1999, he was appointed as the Assistant to the Presiding Bishop of the March of Faith Outreach Ministries, Inc. As a skilled and accomplished entrepreneur, Pastor Arije owned two companies, Unik Consortium LLC, Inc., and Wesley Real Estates and Investments. In his construction company, he designed and built multi-million dollar mansions in Memphis, TN, Collierville, TN, Dallas, TX, and Seattle, WA. He currently owns a fully licensed mechanic shop, leases out two daycare centers and several rental properties in the City of Memphis. Bishop Arije is retired as Administrator for the City of Memphis government after 25 years of service.

After the demise of Dyersburg Christian Center's founding pastor, Pearlie M. Qualls, Bishop C.W. Gillespie appointed Bishop Arije as Pastor in March 2003. God set His approval upon the ministry as evidenced by the increasing growth of the congregation and by the visible presence of his anointing in the services.

As the services became packed, trying to find a larger venue became a primary focus. On Resurrection Sunday in April of 2003, the church made a commitment to purchase the properties at Finley Street. Ten months later the congregation celebrated God's blessings and burned the mortgage as the church was paid in full. Then in July 2004, the church purchased 28 acres of prime land with an additional 3 acres of frontage land purchased in the year 2008. This land has become widely known as the site of "The Holy Dome", a multipurpose facility that will serve both the needs of the ministry and the community.

In 2010, Pastor Arije accepted the invitation of his superior and the selection of his peers to the Bishopric. Even though he has done foundational work for this office in the past, and having been prophesied into his life regarding the next elevation of God for him, he waited until several other events had taken place to move into the calling of Bishop. He was consecrated in 2010 during a lavish ceremony with many Ecclesial Governances from around the world in attendance to celebrate the event.

In March 2017, God blessed the ministry with a beautiful campus located at 4170 Riverdale Road in Memphis, TN. The property spans 7.61 acres of prime real estate in East Memphis. Further proof of God's Hand was that the property already had a contract with another potential buyer when Bishop laid his eyes on the site. Not swayed by anyone, Bishop Arije stood on the Word of God, removed his shoes and socks, and placed his feet on the parking lot. He recited Psalms 24:1, "The earth is the Lord's, and the fullness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein." Not many days later, Pavilion of Hope Memphis became a reality.

In August 2017, Pavilion of Hope Dyersburg purchased another new location. The Lord truly duplicated the ministry beyond anybody's imagination, but as Bishop often quotes, "We ain't seen nothing yet!"

In March 2018, God did it again – another expansion opened for POH in the Frayser community. The property, located at 2869 Woodlawn Terrace, is at the center of the innercity, and kingdom workers are eager to spread the Gospel in the neighborhoods.

In 2020, during a global pandemic, Pavilion of Hope - Caruthersville, MO was birthed. In June 2021, the fifth campus, Pavilion of Hope - Bolivar, was launched.

Pavilion of Hope Ministries is a thriving and moving vehicle by which the Gospel of Jesus Christ is spread. The visionaries, Bishop & Pastor Arije, work tirelessly to ensure that the ministry is equipped to "seek and save that which is lost."

oBishop Arije is a world-renowned orator and author. He has published three awesome books, "Soaring as Eagles: Unleashing the Christian Eagle Within," "Created to Hear the Voice of God" and The Power of the Communion: The Secret of the Grain, the Wine and the Oil. He has traveled the world and gone as far as Saudi Arabia sharing the good news. He is the Dean of the School of Prophets and he is the Bishop that Pastors the Pastors and Shepherds the Shepherds in the monthly Gathering of the Shepherd meetings.

Bishop Arije and his wife, Pastor Betty, have been married for over 40 years and have 3 children, Victor "Deji" Arije, Eyitayo "Toya" Arije-Antwine and Melody "Babylove" Arije and 5 grandchildren.

Dr. Phillip G. Goudeaux

Dr. Goudeaux is the founder of Calvary Christian Center, multicultural ministry, which comprises nine additional campus locations in Northern California. He is also the founder of Faith Covenant Ministries International (FCMI), an international coalition of ministries and businesses organized to build the leadership

capacity of kings and priests by providing resources, skill-building workshops, and networking opportunities.

Dr. Goudeaux also established the National Christian Chamber of Commerce to provide resources and connections to the Christian business community and oversees a ministry for the homeless called SafeHaven; a Men and Women's Drug Program, and works collaboratively with several community organizations.

Dr. Goudeaux was raised in a turbulent environment by a single mother, which provided the catalyst for his acclaimed book and ministry series *Where are the Fathers*. It opens the eyes to readers that Jesus Christ is a father to the fatherless. And his Witnessing Institute Curriculum is impacting churches and communities across the nation.

As a committed Pastor, civic leader, and international speaker, Dr. Goudeaux has received numerous civic and religious awards. They include: the 2006 President's Call to Service Award from the President's Council on Service and Civic Participation by President George W. Bush, the Outstanding Community Service Award from the Southwest Regional Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., the Outstanding Community Service Award by Senator John T. Doolittle, and the International Convention of Faith Ministries (ICFM) District Director of the Year. He was recognized in 2009 by Center for Fathers and Families as Father of the Year.

As an advocate for the preservation of Christian family values, Dr. Goudeaux was appointed by President Bill Clinton to serve as an Advisory Board member on the Committee for the Restoration of Black Families. Additionally, the Mayor and the City Council of Sacramento presented a Resolution for the Betterment of Humanity, honoring Dr. Goudeaux's contributions in building healthy communities in Sacramento. The California State Senate also honored Dr. Goudeaux with a Certificate of Recognition for Faithful Ministry.

In addition to being a world-renown pastor, teacher, author, and motivational speaker, Dr. Phillip G. Goudeaux is a committed and loving husband to his wife of 48 years, Dr. Brenda K. Goudeaux, and a devoted father to their three adult children who work alongside him in the ministry.
