

## **WORD FOR THE MONTH**

What is Passion? Passion is any very strong emotion, enthusiasm, a strong inclination towards something you like. Scripture Matthew 6:33 (NLT) Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need.

We may have passion for many things but we must develop a strong inclination toward the kingdom of God

and his righteousness then we must seek it above all else. What is man that you are mindful of him? And the son of man that you visit him? Psa. 8:4

This scripture seem befitting for the honor bestowed upon us by God in bring an icon such as Dr. Juanita Bynum into our midst. We give veneration and honor to whom honor is due. It was not just one night of emotional exhilaration but three nights of soul stirring, correction, realignment and repositioning. It was indeed a "Divine Shift"!

The Doctor was truly in the house. She taught with precision and succinct. Not one word was wasted. The table was spread and the feast of the word of God was rich. It was bitter at times to our mouth but satisfying to the soul and spirit. The bitterness of truth is needed in this season to get the body of Christ to abnegation of the hidden works of dishonesty, folly, profaneness and spurious deeds being done in the church and on his altar. Through repentance and humility these three days led to an examination and a deep cleansing of our own personal prayer altars. Because what we see manifesting in the church is a result of the breakdown and neglect of our own temples, precisely our prayer altars.

Dr. Bynum expounded on the Old Testament temple that was the template for a sinless man, Jesus Christ. We are in Christ through our confession of faith and we are the temple of the Holy Ghost. When we understand who we are in Christ and operate in faith and His fullness, the God of peace sanctifies us wholly, spirit, soul and body.

Our body is the outer court, our soul is the inner court and our spirit is the holy of holies where the Spirit of God lives. We must present our bodies as a living sacrifice...(body represents the mind) holy and acceptable unto God. We must be transformed by the renewing of our minds. That transformation of the mind happens by the word of God. The word of God is a living word it works with your anatomy. When you feed the body (mind) the word of God it speaks to your brain particularly the frontal lobe that changes your behavior.

You experience behavior changes when you give yourself information (the word of God).

We find ourselves falling back into sin because we have not provided the brain with enough information to modify behavior. So the brain goes back into old behaviors which is recorded in the mind of the heart. We must hide the word in our hearts so we don't sin against God. We must abide because it is only a faithful man that shall abide in blessings not an indecisive man.

The stability of our temple is based on our relationship to our personal prayer altars. Our individual altars in our personal temples will reflect in our churches. Dr. Bynum elucidated the sacred altar of God with the kingdom vernacular that was refreshing and reviving to the church body. Those that yielded to the Spirit and Wisdom of God truly experienced a "Divine Shift" and recalibration. For that we give God glory!!!


